Parents, make sure you come in and get your children signed up today so they can be a part of what we hope is going to make life a little easier for you.

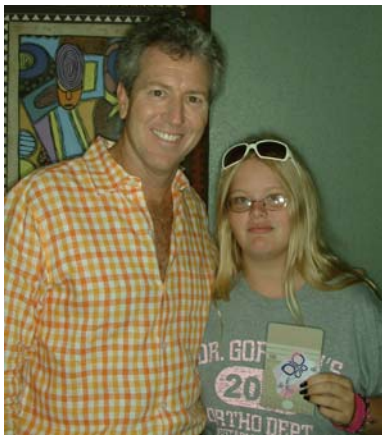

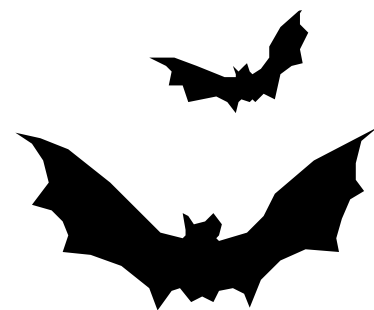
